

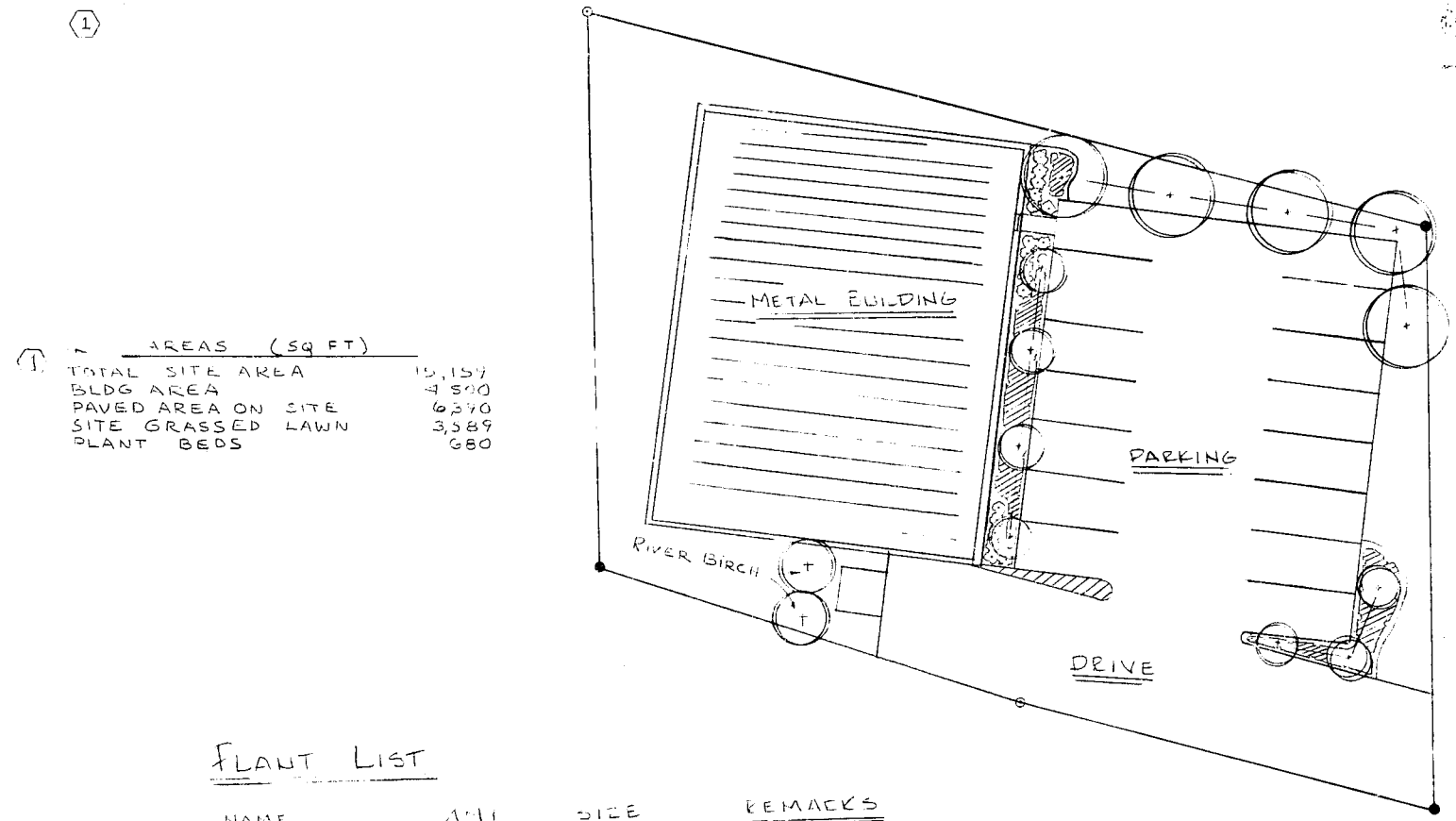

- GROUP PLANTINGS HAVE KEY LETTERS FOLLOWED BY THE QUANTITY OF THAT PLANT IN THAT PARTICULAR AREA OR GROUP.
- QUANTITIES SHOWN FOR GROUND COVER PLANTING OR MASS PLANTING AREAS ARE FOR REFERENCE ONLY. EXACT QUANTITY TAKE-OFF IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THIS CONTRACTOR.
- LOCATIONS FOR PROPOSED PLANT BEDS AND TREES CAN BE ESTABLISHED BY USING SCALED DIMENSIONS TAKEN FROM PLANTING PLAN. USE WALKS, DRIVES, BUILDINGS, ETC. AS REFERENCES.
- ALL PLANTS SHALL BE COMPACT, UNIFORM, AND WELL GROWN. PLANTS SHALL NOT BE LOOSE, OPEN PLANTS.
- ALL AREAS DISTURBED BY GRADING OPERATIONS AND UTILITY LINE PLACEMENT SHALL BE GRASSED.
- ALL PLANTING BEDS SHALL RECEIVE A MINIMUM OF 2" APPROVED MULCH.
- EXISTING AND PROPOSED TREES SHALL BE TRIMMED AS INSTRUCTED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT, AND AS DETAILED.
- ALL PLANTS SHALL MEET OR EXCEED THE MINIMUM STANDARDS SET FORTH IN THE AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK BY THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERMEN, INC., WASHINGTON, DC.
