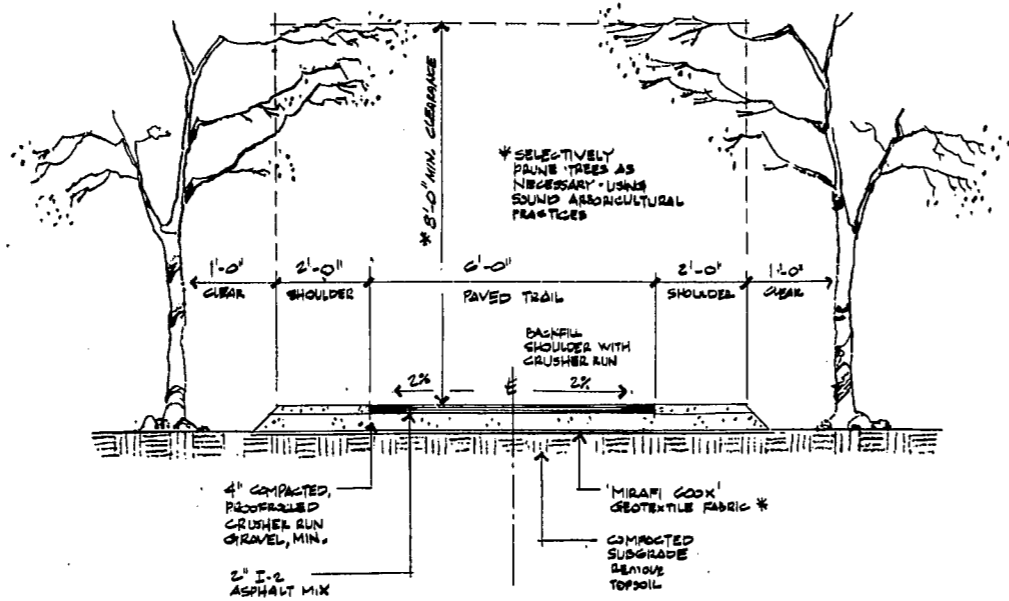


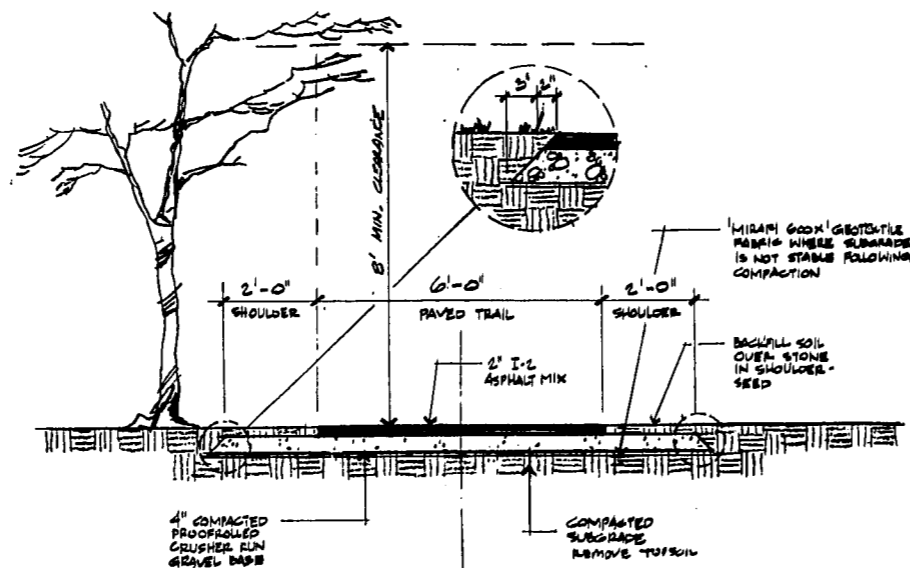
NOTES:

- Contractor shall notify Landscape Architect immediately of any site conditions which vary significantly from those indicated on plans.
- Where practical, trails should be graded at 5% or less along their length and 2% or less cross slope to facilitate access for the disabled.
- Grade as necessary to eliminate ruts and mounds and to undercut for trail placement. Except where indicated on the plans or directed by the Landscape Architect the finish trail surface should be as close to surrounding existing grade as is practical.
- Clearing and all land disturbing activities should be kept to a minimum. A maximum of 12,000 square feet of disturbed is allowed at any one time during construction.

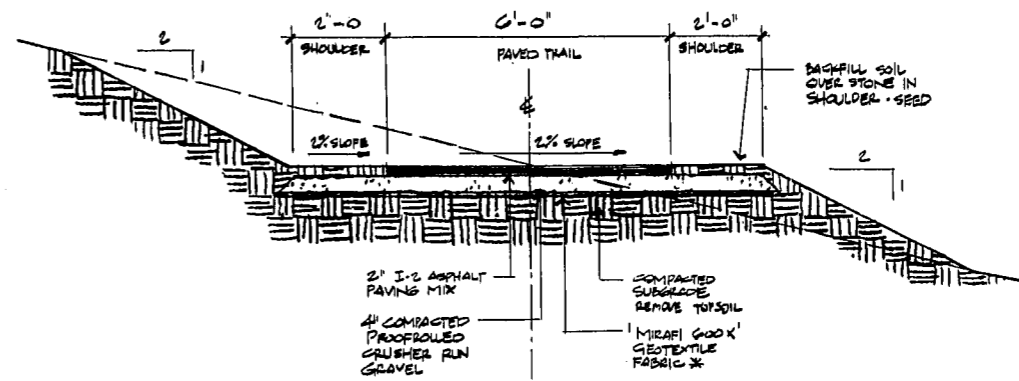


TYPE I-D TYPE TRAIL
SCALE: 1/2"=1'-0"

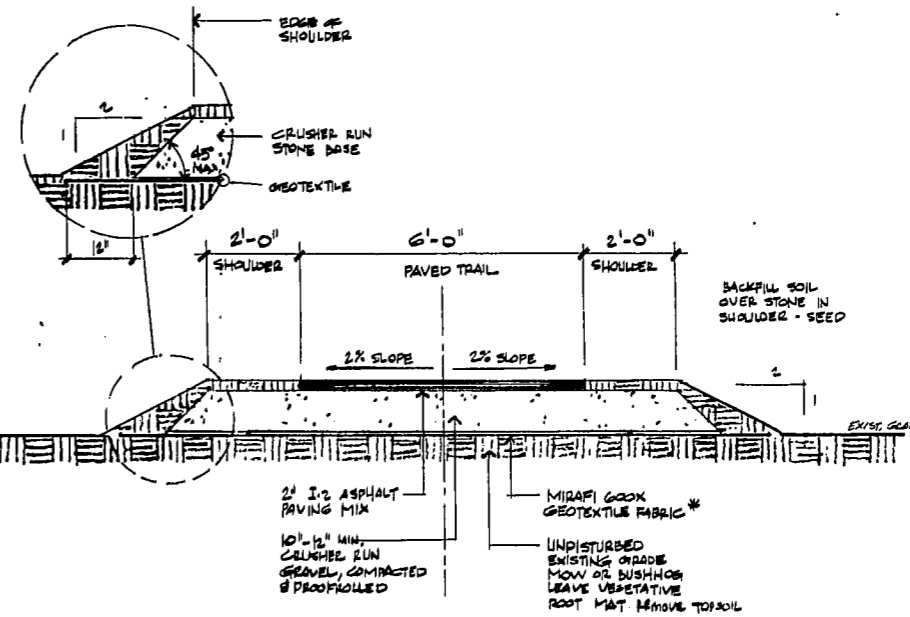
FILL AREAS

NO UNDERCUT



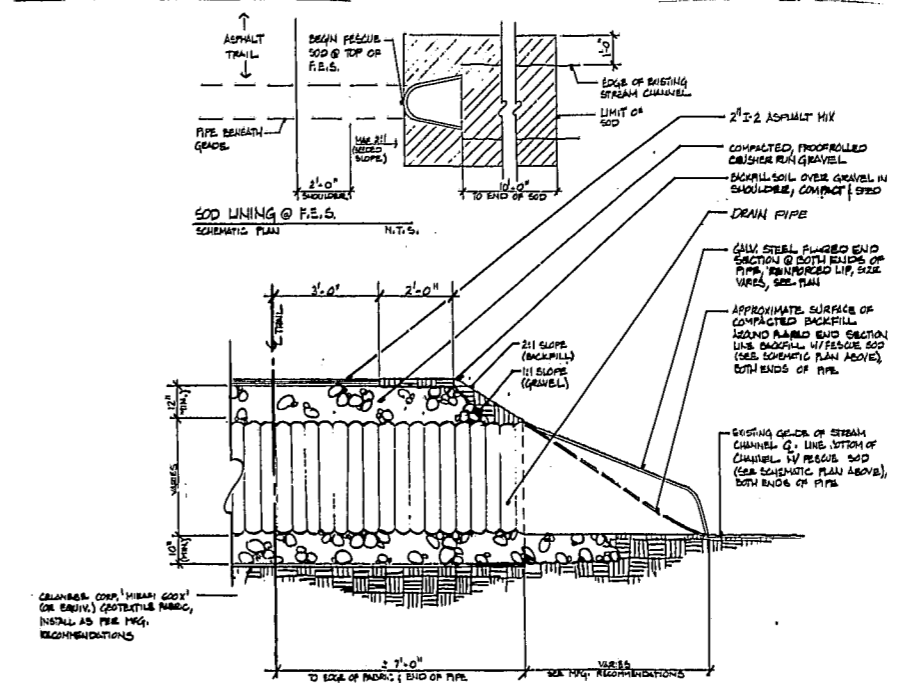
TYPE 1-A TRAIL
