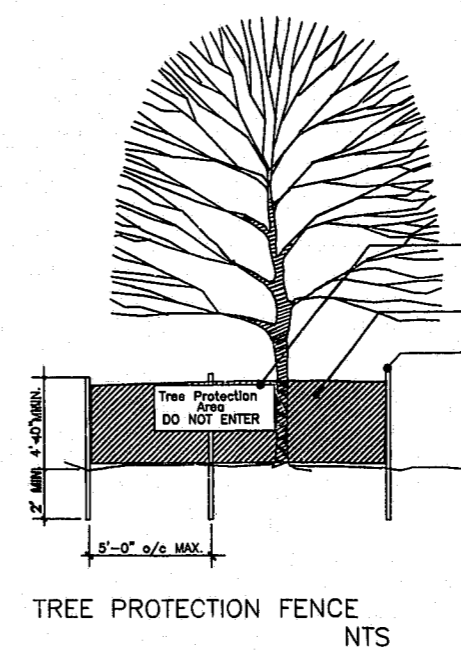


- LANDSCAPE NOTES
- CONTRACTOR SHALL REVIEW PLANTING PLAN WITH LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
 - ALL PLANTS SHALL BE SET FOR EQUAL SPACING PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
 - TREE LOCATIONS SHALL BE STAKED OR TREES SET IN PLACE PRIOR TO PLANTING FOR APPROVAL.
 - FIELD ADJUSTMENT MAY BE REQUIRED TO ADAPT PLAN FUNCTIONALLY & AESTHETICALLY TO SITE.
 - PLANT MATERIAL SCHEDULE IS PROVIDED FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF CONTRACTOR. THE PLAN PREVAILS IF THERE ARE DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN THE SCHEDULE & PLAN.
 - NO SUBSTITUTIONS SHALL BE MADE AT THE TIME OF BIDDING.
 - B&B PLANTS OF EQUAL SIZE MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR CONTAINER GROWN MATERIAL & VICE VERSA.
 - ALL PLANT BEDS INCLUDING INDIVIDUAL PLANT SAUCERS, SHALL BE MULCHED WITH 3" OF FRESH MEDIUM BARK MULCH FREE OF STICKS, CONES, & OTHER DEBRIS.
 - CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY LOCATION OF UNDERGROUND UTILITIES PRIOR TO DIGGING OR PLANTING. FIELD ADJUSTMENT BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT IF CONFLICTS IDENTIFIED.
 - CONTRACTOR TO CONTACT LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT FOR ON SITE INSPECTION & APPROVAL OF MATERIAL PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
 - ALL MATCHED MATERIALS IDENTIFIED IN PLANT SCHEDULE ARE TO BE OF UNIFORM HEIGHT & SHAPE.
 - WHERE EXISTING VEGETATION FAILS TO FUNCTION ADEQUATELY AS THE REQUIRED BUFFER TYPE, THE CARY SITE INSPECTOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REQUIRE SUPPLEMENTAL PLANTINGS IN ADDITION TO THOSE SHOWN ON THE PLANTING PLAN, BASED ON ACTUAL CONDITIONS.
 - THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY & THEIR AGENTS, HEIRS, OR ASSIGNS, SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INSTALLATION, PRESERVATION & MAINTENANCE OF ALL PLANTING & PHYSICAL FEATURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN. THE OWNERS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF THE VEGETATION TO INCLUDE & NOT BE LIMITED TO:
 - FERTILIZATION: LAWNS, FERTILIZE TWICE PER YEAR (FEB. 15 - MARCH 15 & AGAIN SEPT. 1 - OCT 31) ACCORDING TO SOIL TEST. FERTILIZE WARM SEASON GRASSES ONCE DURING GROWING SEASON PER SOIL TEST.
 - PRUNING: PRUNE AS REQUIRED TO REMOVE DAMAGED, DEAD OR CROSS OVER BRANCHES. DO NOT PRUNE TREE LEADERS UNLESS DAMAGED. ALL PRUNING TO COMPLY WITH ESTABLISHED PRACTICES OF NATIONAL ARBORIST ASSOCIATION.
 - PEST CONTROL: APPLICATION OF INSECTICIDES AND PESTICIDES ONLY AS NECESSARY TO CONTROL DISEASE OR INSECT INFESTATION. ALL PESTICIDES APPLIED PER MANUFACTURERS SPECIFICATIONS AND BY SUPERVISED AND LICENSED PERSONNEL.
 - MULCHING: MULCH TO BE MAINTAINED AT A DEPTH OF 3" IN PLANT BEDS MULCH TO BE REAPPLIED AT LEAST EVERY 2 YEARS.
 - MOWING: MOWING SHOULD BE DONE AS NEEDED, GENERALLY EVERY 5-7 DAYS DURING PEAK GROWTH AND TO A HEIGHT OF 3".
 - ROOT ZONE PROTECTION: AVOID EXCESSIVE INTRUSION INTO ROOT ZONE AREA OF ESTABLISHED PLANTINGS, ESPECIALLY WITH HEAVY EQUIPMENT.
 - IRRIGATION: IF AN IRRIGATION SYSTEM IS INSTALLED, SYSTEM SHALL BE REGULATED TO PROVIDE APPROX. 1" OF WATER PER WEEK DURING THE GROWING SEASON.
 - FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ALL PLANTINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLAN MAY CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE & MAY RESULT IN FINES.

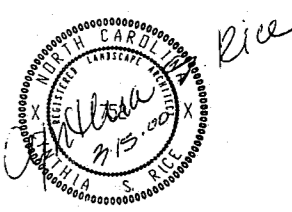
WEATHERPROOF SIGN, MADE OF DURABLE MATERIAL LETTERS TO BE 3" HIGH, CLEARLY LEGIBLE. ATTACH SIGNS SECURELY TO FENCE POSTS & FABRIC SIGNS ARE TO BE PLACED NO GREATER THAN 200' O.C. PLACE SIGNS AT EACH END OF LINEAR AREA. MIN. ONE SIGN PER PROTECTION AREA. ADDITIONAL SIGNS MAY BE REQUIRED. SIGNS MUST BE AT LEAST 2'X2'.

ORANGE, UV RESISTANT, HIGH-TENSILE STRENGTH, POLY BARRICADE FABRIC

POST MAY BE EITHER 4" DIA. PINE, 2" DIA. OAK, OR 1.33 LB/FT STEEL

TOWN OF CARY STANDARDS:
FENCE TO BE PLACED A MIN. OF 1' FROM THE TREE TRUNK FOR EVERY 1" IN TREE DIAMETER, BUT SHALL IN NO CASE BE LESS THAN 10' FROM TRUNK OF TREES.
ENSURE DIVERSION DITCHES & GRADING ARE LOCATED FAR ENOUGH AWAY FROM THE EDGE OF THE TREELINE TO AVOID DAMAGING TREES LOCATED AT THE BUFFERS EDGE.
